



PREFACE.

JOHAN SANDS has again the pleasure of introducing his **SYDNEY AND SUBURBAN DIRECTORY** to the general public of Sydney and neighbourhood, and for their guidance would respectfully submit the following Key in order to facilitate reference.

The **GENERAL INDEX** (pages v. and vi.) is an alphabetically arranged list of every item in the book. Immediate reference to this will save much time and trouble.

The **CITY STREETS DIRECTORY** (pages 1 to 151) is arranged in alphabetical order of names of streets, showing where they commence, and the intersecting and terminal streets, together with the numbers of the houses in the main thoroughfares. This will be found very useful in tracing the exact locality of the more obscure and smaller houses.

The **SUBURBAN DIRECTORY** (pages 153 to 630) is compiled on the lines of the City streets, so far as possible. The respective Municipalities and Suburbs are shown in alphabetical order, with their boundaries, together with the rates, official lists, &c., corrected up to date.

The **ALPHABETICAL DIRECTORY** (pages 632 to 1076) contains the Institutions, also business, professional and private persons resident in Sydney and suburbs, arranged in alphabetical order in the following sequence:—Where entries commence with the same surname, institutions and public bodies take precedence; next come the names of public companies, followed by partnership firms, then the names of individual business and professional people, and lastly private persons.

A **PASTORAL SECTION** giving the names of the principal Sheep and Stock holders, together with the name of Station, Post Town, and Stock District, is included in this issue, which the publisher has no doubt will prove useful to the trading community. (See pages 1077 to 1122.)

An **ECCLESIASTICAL LIST** is also included in the work. (See pages 1331 to 1333.)

For **EDUCATIONAL LIST** see pages 1326 to 1330.

The **TRADES AND PROFESSIONAL DIRECTORY** (pages 1123 to 1324) contains lists of the trading and professional community only. Index of headings will be found at pages xxix. to xxxiii. As much difficulty is experienced in gaining full and accurate information for this Section, it has been considered expedient to classify them according to the instructions given to the canvassers—a reference to similar trades being placed under each heading.

A list of the Justices of the Peace will be found on pages 1239 to 1244, compiled from official sources.

A list of leading European Manufacturers will be found at pages 1334 and 1335.

The **MISCELLANEOUS DIRECTORY** (pages 1336 to 1351) includes Governmental and Parliamentary Lists, Civil, Naval, and Military information, kindly revised to the latest date by Government and other officials, to whom the publisher tenders his best thanks.

A list of firms with fixed pay-days (pages 1359 to 1367) will be found useful in business circles.

Whilst thanking the subscribers and the public generally, the publisher begs to say that the whole of the information has been **COLLECTED, COMPILED, AND PRINTED BY A STAFF RESIDENT IN AND KNOWING THE CITY AND SUBURBS**; therefore this edition should be as complete and reliable as it is possible to render so voluminous a work.

THE CITY OF SYDNEY

Is bounded on the west by Newtown road, commencing at the junction of Cleveland street, and thence to George street west; from thence by Bay street to the shore of Black Wattle Cove, thence by the waters of Port Jackson to the bridge at the foot of William street east; thence by Rushcutters creek upwards to a culvert on the Old South Head road; thence again on the east by Dowling street to Church street; thence by the southern boundary of Paddington, being Victoria barracks, &c., Leinster and Gordon streets, to Park road; from thence the boundaries of the city include all that piece of land known as Moore Park, and from thence the southern boundary is Cleveland street to the point of commencement.

The City includes WOOLLOOMOOLOO, POTTS' POINT, ELIZABETH BAY, MILLER'S POINT, DARLINGHURST, MOORE PARK, SURREY HILLS, STRAWBERRY HILLS, ULTIMO AND PYRMONT.

Its area is about 2,670 acres, and length of streets and lanes about 100 miles.

Assessed annual value, £1,048,957.

It contains 20,200 houses, and there are 24,628 voters registered.

Estimated population, 100,162.

Sydney was proclaimed a municipality on the 20th July, 1842, and is divided into eight Wards, each represented by three aldermen, whose term of office is respectively three years, eight aldermen retiring from the City Council on the 1st of December in every year, when a new election of eight aldermen takes place.

On the 9th of December in each year the aldermen elect one of their body as Mayor for the ensuing year, who takes office on the 1st of January following.
