

AUBURN.

COUNTY OF CUMBERLAND (parish of Liberty Plains), area about 3·2 square miles: Commencing on the centre of the line of pipes conveying the water supply to Sydney and suburbs at its intersection with a line along the centre of Park road; thence by the western boundary of the borough of Rookwood, as proclaimed 10th December, 1891, being a line along the centre of that road northerly till it meets the westerly prolongation of a line along the centre of Mount Auburn road; thence by that prolongation and a line along the centre of that road easterly till it meets the southerly prolongation of a line along the centre of Graham street; thence by that prolongation and a line along the centre of that street and its prolongation northerly to the centre of Water street; thence by a line along the centre of that street easterly till it meets the southerly prolongation of a line along the centre of Cockthorp road; thence by that prolongation and by a line along the centre of that road northerly to the northern side of Helena street; thence by a line east to the centre of Thomas street; thence by a line along the centre of that street and its prolongation northerly to the southernmost boundary fence of Ritchie's property; thence

by that fence easterly to the south-east corner of that property; thence by the eastern boundary of that property and its prolongation northerly, crossing the railway line from Parramatta to Sydney, to its north-eastern fence; thence by part of that fence north-westerly to meet the southerly prolongation of a line along the centre of Percy road; thence by that prolongation and by a line along the centre of that road northerly and north-easterly till it meets the easterly prolongation of a line along the centre of Hall street; thence by that prolongation and a line along the centre of that street westerly to the centre of St. Hillier's road; thence by a line along the centre of that road and its prolongation north-easterly to the centre of the Parramatta road; thence by a line along the centre of that road north-westerly to the centre of Duck river; thence by a line along the centre of that river southerly to the centre of the water supply pipes aforesaid; thence by a line along the centre of the line of water supply pipes south-easterly to the point of commencement—as shown on plan catalogued D.G. 77 in the Local Government Office, Sydney.
